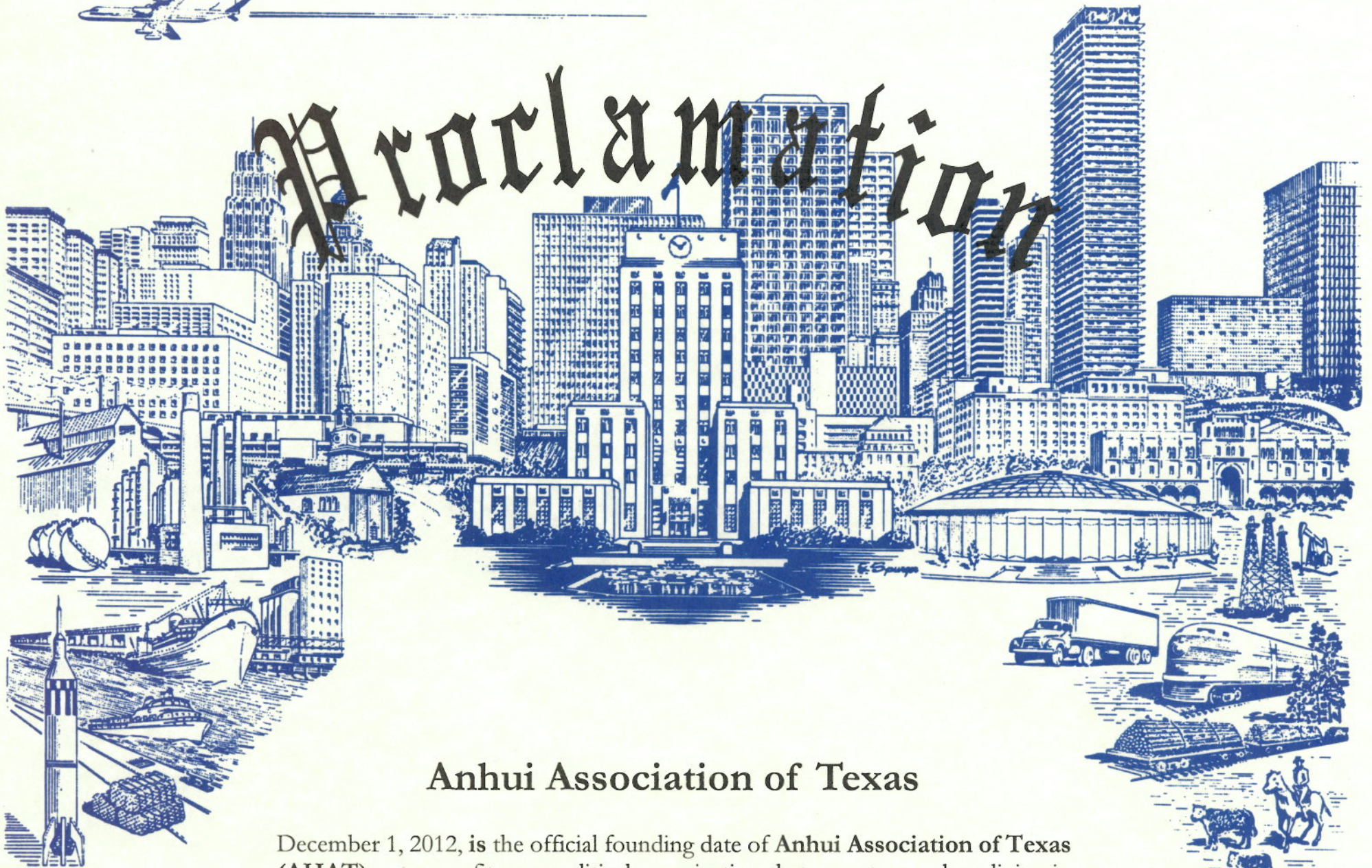




Proclamation
